Supervisory Responsibility: Controller, Senior Budget Analyst, Executive Secretary, Financial Aid Director, and Facilities Director

Job Summary: The Vice President for Finance is the Chief Financial Officer of the University who collaborates with the President, the President's Council, and the Board of Trustees in directing and overseeing institutional financial activities and controls and physical plant, while protecting and facilitating the growth of financial and capital assets. The Vice President for Finance is responsible for leading and directing a disciplined and transparent budget process, guiding the investment strategy, creatively enhancing and developing new streams of revenue, and serving as the primary liaison with third parties providing outsourced services. The Vice President for Finance reports directly to the President and has a total of five direct reports, including the Controller, Senior Budget Analyst, Financial Aid Director, Facilities Director, and Executive Secretary.

Essential Functions:

1. Sustain financial equilibrium and build the endowment.
2. Optimize streams of revenue.
3. Provide for the overall condition of campus physical facilities.
4. Reinforce openness and transparency.
5. Lead and mentor the division.
6. Support enrollment management efforts.
7. Advocate for OLLU and higher education.
